

How long can a high-power cruise ship battery last



Overview

AIDA Cruises is using the biggest battery ever placed on a cruise ship of this size. The Carnival Corporation & plc owned cruise line is using a Corvis Energy battery. The 10 megawatt-hour battery consists of 1,800 cells. Havila Voyages operates four cruise ships along the coast of Norway. Each vessel is powered by some of the largest battery packs at sea and can operate for up to four straight hours on. Another cruise line that sails along the coast of Norway is Hurtigruten. In fact, the company sails to all kinds of arctic regions and specializes in expedition style, and destination focus. Viking Cruises is world-renowned for their Viking Longships, which sail along the rivers of Europe and throughout the world. And now some of these vessels offer a hybrid propulsion. And then there's the vessel made in China that has been touted as the "world's largest electric cruise ship". The Yangtze River Three Gorges 1 is not a hybrid. It is 100% powered by a 7,500 kWh battery.

Moreover, it can reach speeds of up to 17.5 knots on battery power alone and is designed for potential upgrades for full battery operation in the future. The vessel has the capacity to carry 1,300 passengers and provides 2,410 lane meters for cargo, with 176 lane meters allocated for personal vehicles.

And then there's the vessel made in China that has been touted as the "world's largest electric cruise ship". The Yangtze River Three Gorges 1 is not a hybrid. It is 100% powered by a 7,500 kWh battery system. The 300-foot long ship is not really a cruise ship but is designed as a sightseeing vessel along the Yangtze River in China.

Portable power battery power stations (not banks)

To answer your question I could see the ship having an issue with a large battery power station. Airplanes limit batteries to a relatively low 100Wh rating due to the associated risk and I could see a ship also establishing a similar cap on the size of a battery station given the potential risk associated with these types of devices.

How Long Can a Cruise Ship Stay Out At Sea For?

Several different factors can change the length of time a cruise ship can last at sea before needing to refuel: Ship size - The size of cruise ships varies dramatically with some holding as little as 100 passengers and others carrying upwards of 6000.

How Much Electricity Does A Cruise Ship Use?

How much power does a cruise ship use in port? 7-11 MW Shore power for cruise ships consists of an installation plant both on the quay and on the ship, to enable cables to be taken on board that can deliver power to the ship while it is in port. The ships typically use 7-11 MW today, so a very large connection is needed to make this possible.

For every 1-kilowatt hour (KWh) of battery power, 6000 litres of vapour are produced. A single 55 KWh battery could produce 330,000 litres of vapour. Significantly increased likelihood of re-ignition of a BEV fire. These fires are a chemical chain reaction, cooling with water slows the reaction but doesn't stop it completely.

Costa Cruises plans pilot using batteries for large ship zero ...

The plan is to install a battery power supply system, likely combined with a shore power/recharging system for the batteries. According to Costa, this would eliminate emissions from the ship for half a day between the time spent on the dock and maneuvering.

How many volts are normal for a high-power cruise ship battery

A standard 12-volt battery should have a voltage between 13.5 and 14.5 volts when the car is running. However, you should keep in mind that a battery that reads low isn't necessarily dying. The best way to find out if your battery is dying is to read the voltage on your battery several times over an extended period.

How big of a battery would you need for a EV cruise ship ...

Those cruises vary in length, but 9 sea days would be fairly typical. So lets assume the battery was sized to enable a ship to complete a repositioning cruise. Power requirements for a ship also vary significantly, but max propulsive power of 40 - 50 MW is typical for the average cruise ship.
