

Requirements for land transportation of lithium batteries



Overview

ADR 2025 introduces several significant changes for the transport of lithium batteries by road. The main changes are stricter test criteria for batteries, more extensive requirements for temperature control during transport, and new regulations for the transport of used and damaged. The ADR regulations for lithium batteries will undergo significant changes in 2025 that will affect road transport. The new regulations impose stricter requirements on packaging, classification and documentation in order to increase safety during transport. If you work with lithium batteries, it is.
