

Thailand's containerized energy storage policy



Overview

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Thailand's Renewable Power Development Plan (RPDP) targets 14 GW of energy storage by 2037 to support a grid running on 51% renewable electricity (Ember, 2025). As of early 2026, the country has roughly 2,685 MW of storage capacity operational or awarded — just 19% of. The Royal Thai Government is developing the 2024-2037 National Energy Plan (NEP), planned for release by end-2025, and the Power Development Plan (PDP) within it is expected to raise the share of renewable energy in total electricity generation to 51%, up from 36% under PDP 2018. That shift is.
